

Beverley Racecourse 2021 Ticketing Terms and Conditions

1. The Terms and Conditions upon which this ticket is issued by Beverley Racecourse are set out below. The acceptance of this ticket shall constitute acceptance by the ticket holder of these Terms and Conditions. A breach of these Terms and Conditions shall render the ticket void and all rights conferred or evidenced by it shall be nullified.
2. Beverley Racecourse reserves the right in its sole discretion, to refuse admission to the ticket holder to the course to remove the ticket holder from the course or to direct the ticket holder to another part of the course.
3. Entry into the course will be authorised on a race day only upon the presentation of a valid ticket by each ticket holder seeking to gain entrance, with the exception of under 18s. Individuals who have been banned from attending racedays by competent authorities or sports governing bodies in any jurisdiction, or who are considered as a security risk, are prohibited from entering or remaining at the course. On entering the course, the ticket holder agrees to abide by course regulations at all times.
4. The instructions of Management and Staff must be obeyed at all times, ticket holders must truthfully answer any question concerning a ticket from a steward or member of Management and ticket holders agree to be searched.
5. If the ticket holder is refused admission or removed, no money shall be refunded.
6. A ticket is non-refundable and non-transferable
7. The ticket is only valid for the Enclosure it was purchased for, unless you transfer at a registered Transfer Booth on the day (if permitted on that raceday).
8. Tickets may only be purchased from Beverley Racecourse or officially authorised agents of Beverley Racecourse. Any ticket obtained from any other source (for example, unauthorised intermediaries such as ticket brokers, internet auctions, internet ticket agents) will be rendered void, and all rights of entry onto the course will be nullified. Any person seeking to use such a ticket obtained through unauthorised sources will be refused entry, ejected and/or will have their ticket seized by the Management, in addition to other remedies available to the Management
9. Upon request from Management, ticket holders must explain how, from whom, where and for what consideration they obtained their tickets.
10. Ticket Holders are permitted to exit and re-enter the course but must retain their ticket for inspection.
11. This ticket shall not be used as a prize in any lottery or competition or for any other promotional or advertising purposes unless expressly authorised in writing by Beverley Racecourse.
12. Beverley Racecourse, its servants or agents shall have no liability for loss injury or damage to the ticket holder, or his/her property while in the grounds or any part thereof on entering or leaving the course, whether caused by negligence or breach of contract of the Beverley Racecourse or any of its servants or agents or otherwise.
13. All ticket holders acknowledge that photographic images and/or video recordings and/or stills taken from those video recordings may be taken of them and may also be used by Beverley Racecourse for marketing or promotional purposes.
14. Purchase of a ticket constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions and regulations. Breach of these regulations and/or terms and conditions shall render the ticket void.

Ticket categories:

- Adult: Adult (18+) tickets for the Premier, Grandstand & Paddock and Course Enclosures
- Hospitality: Hospitality badges are purchased as part of a hospitality package and allow access to all areas.
- Group: Group booking discounts are available for all parties of 20 & over into all Enclosures except the Premier Enclosure on Ladies' Day.
- Under 18s: Under 18s do not require a ticket and may accompany a paying adult into whichever Enclosure they hold a ticket for.
- Concessions - Student: To be eligible for a Student Season Ticket as a Student you must have valid student ID to accompany your pre-purchased ticket or when purchasing.
- Concessions - Senior: People aged over 65. IDs will be required to be produced for entry either alongside your pre-purchased ticket or when purchasing.
